

Changing MUMS from UNC to MAP

MUMS runs much faster using Mapped Network Drive letters than using Universal Naming Convention.

If inside of MUMS at the bottom of the screen it shows your tables are:

Tables: \\servername\sharename\mt2000\tables

Then you are using UNC. It should read:

Tables : m:\tables

Step #1: Map:

- Map Network Drive letters such as **M** to the servers mt2000 folder so that if you were to click on M you would see Tables and Reports folders.

Step #2: BDE:

- On Windows Menu, look for MUMS2000 and click on BDE Config
 - Click on Configuration tab
 - Double click, Configuration, Drives, Native
 - Single click Paradox
 - Change the NET DIR on the right from long path to **m:**
 - Click on field below NET DIR just to get off change
 - Use Red X in corner to exit and save & confirm

Step #3: INI

- On the workstation, go into C:\MT2000\System Folder
- Click on MT2000.ini file or MT2000 configuration File
 - Change lines two & three to read as follows:

TableDir=m:\tables
ReportsDir=m:\reports

- Exit and save
- Enter MUMS from your desktop and all should be OK.
